### Online Courses available for East Palestine Memorial Public Library Cardholders

East Palestine Memorial Public Library users with a valid library card now have access to thousands of online courses. Lynda.com has over 12,000 self-guided courses to help people gain workforce skills. Classes range from a few minutes to several hours long. Lynda.com usually requires a paid subscription, but East Palestine Library cardholders have access to courses from any computer with an internet connection simply by entering your library card number, and 4-digit pin (last 4-digits of your telephone number).

### Stream and Download Movies, TV Shows, Audiobooks and eBooks Using Your Library Card



Hoopla is a program that allows East Palestine Memorial Public Library patrons to use their library account to electronically borrow movies, TV episodes, music, eBooks, and audiobooks, and access them from any compatible device.

Unlike other streaming audio and video services, patrons do not pay a monthly subscription fee making hoopla the first app of its kind. The app is designed for users of all ages and skill levels, and is as easy to navigate as the library shelves. Best of all, with mobile devices, hoopla allows you to take the library with you wherever you go.

Patrons who have a 4-digit barcode will need to update their card at the library. Stop by the library to get your new card before using this service. Mack, our Guiding Ohio Online trainer, will be available to help you set up your account, and to answer questions about using hoopla. Call the library at 330-426-3778 to make an appointment.

### ROKU Streaming Sticks are Now Available for Check Out

All you need is High Speed Internet and a television that accepts an HDMI plug. The ROKU's circulate for one week with one renewal. They can be placed on reserve and cannot be renewed if another patron is waiting.

**Chilton Library**— A car repair database which includes step-by step service and repair procedures, and a labor estimating tool. Wiring diagrams and close-up photographs and illustrations can also be found here.

**Fold3**— This database provides convenient access to military records including the stories, photos, and personal documents of the men & women who served.

**Heritage Quest**— This genealogy database includes U.S. Census records, City Directories, Immigration Records, and more.
