

Paint Class Supply List

Hello! I'm so happy you'll be participating in this art class! Here is a list of supplies you will need, with options and stores where they can be found.

Canvases

For this class, I would recommend having at least 3-5 canvases ready.

Here are a few different canvas options.

Canvas Panels - a great, budget-friendly option, often come in packs of 3-5.

Stretched Canvas - a higher quality option, where the canvas has been wrapped around a wooden frame called a stretcher.

Canvas Paper - can often be bought in pads of 10 or more sheets, a good option for practice.

Size - Size is up to you and what you would like to make. I would recommend getting canvases that range from 8" x 8" to 16" x 20." Of course, you can go smaller or larger than this.

Acrylic Paint

I would recommend getting paint in bottles that have at least 2 fl oz.

Craft Paint - a great option, often sold in 2 fl oz bottles for as low as \$0.50 - \$1.00 each.

You can also choose to get artist paint from the art supplies section in stores like Michaels or Hobby Lobby. While the paint is much higher quality, it is more expensive. If this is something you are interested in, they do offer some pretty good sales.

Colors - I would make sure to have at least red, yellow, blue, and white. Any other colors are up to you. You can either get a set of paints with colors already assorted for you, or you can choose individual colors that speak to you.

Brushes

Any set of acrylic or multimedia paintbrushes should work. Try to find a set that offers a wide range of sizes. You may also want to consider getting a 1" - 2" inch brush as well.

There are a lot of options when it comes to getting these supplies. Some stores I like to shop at for art supplies are Michaels and Hobby Lobby. Walmart also has some good options for art supplies and may be a more budget-friendly option. Amazon is also a good place to look.
