Hoopla is a program that allows East Palestine Memorial Public Library patrons to use their library account to electronically borrow movies, TV episodes, music, ebooks, and audiobooks, and access them from any compatible device.

Unlike other streaming audio and video services, patrons do not pay a monthly subscription fee making hoopla the first app of its kind. The app is designed for users of all ages and skill levels, and is as easy to navigate as the library shelves. Best of all, with mobile devices, hoopla allows you to take the library with you wherever you go.

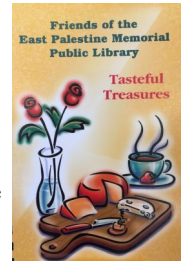
